

Six Dates That Has Shaped Israel's Willingness To Accept Peace At All Costs

1947 – Israel Becomes A Nation – War Of Independence

- 1957 – War With Egypt, Syria and Jordan – Israel Attacks Egypt over Suez Canal
- 1967 – The Six Days War (Jerusalem retaken by Israel for first time since A.D. 70!) It is this date that many believe the clock begins ticking for the “times of the Gentiles” to come to an end and the “generation” Christ spoke of that would see His coming! **GIVE THAT SOME THOUGHT!**
- 1977 – Anwar Sadat becomes first Arab leader to raise olive branch to Israel. This comes four years after 1973 Yom Kippur War, which Sadat tried to stop through secret negotiations with then Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir. Famous peace treaty between Egypt and Israel signed two years later in 1979.
 - 1987 – The beginning of the first intifada of the Palestine Liberation Organization
- 1997 – Israel gives up Bethlehem, Hebron and other key Biblical cities to Palestinians in Wye Agreement architected by the USA State Department under Clinton and Albright.
