


## Messiah in the Feasts of the Lord

Speaks of redemption, Messiah the Passover lamb would be sacrificed for us – His crucifixion	Speaks of sanctification, Messiah's body would see no decay in the grave – His burial	Speaks of glorification, Messiah rose triumphantly on the third day, the firstborn from the dead – His resurrection	Speaks of the outpouring of the Spirit – to Jew and Gentile – in One Body – the inauguration of the New Covenant	Speaks of the return of Messiah to rescue the righteous and judge the wicked	Speaks of days of repentance for sin and turning to the Messiah for salvation	Speaks of the millennial kingdom when God tabernacles with and among man
